2017-18 Kindergarten

As part of the Kindergarten enrollment, parents will be required to complete the Ages and Stages Questionnaire and Assessment with their Kindergarten student before registrations can be accepted.

These will be conducted at the Genesis preschool at the Alliance Church in High River between 12:30-3:00 on Thursday, June 1st.

It usually only takes about 30-45 minutes and gives educators and support staff insight into areas of strengths and weaknesses before beginning school.

Ages & Stages Questionnaires® (ASQ) provides reliable, accurate developmental and social-emotional screening for children between birth and age 6. Drawing on parents' expert knowledge, ASQ has been specifically designed to pinpoint developmental progress and catch delays in young children—paving the way for meaningful next steps in learning, intervention, or monitoring. The areas assessed include: communication, gross motor, fine motor, problem solving, and personal-social.

Mrs. Niemans will also be administering the Brigance Early Childhood Screen which will assess student's Academic, Cognitive, and Language scores.
