Professional Development Brant Christian School 2014/15

- August 25 Having attended John Hattie's conference on Visual Learning I was eager to share my notes with the staff on what Visual Learning is about. The day began with an introduction to who John Hattie was and an outline as to what visual learning was about. We studied the top 10 influences of student achievement. We also looked at five attitudes and beliefs of expert teachers.
 This session carried on for the morning and part of the afternoon. The remainder of Day was given over to teacher time in their classrooms.
- August 26 The morning was spent looking at the accountability pillar for our school.
 discussing ways in which we can add option courses to our schedule and to do more career training and preparation for beyond high school.
 I met with each teacher individually in September to go over their grade 3, 6 and 9 results and discussed areas of strengths and weaknesses. How can they use the results to better teach the curriculum, what areas did the students seem to understand best, etc.
- August 28 The focus of this day was on planning for out second and third goals for the year.
 We looked at ways to improve the relationships across grade levels and within the same. What can be done to reduce the incidence of bullying and what activities and behaviors would help create a greater sense of togetherness. Our third goal, with its focus on unsung heroes of the Bible and our school families dovetails in nicely with our safe and caring goals.
- Additional PD Additional training on Literacy Place from Bev Smith, Oct. 16 and 22. Staff PD goes two Monday's each month after school. Two main areas will be Literacy and Visual Learning.
